Nebraska's School Readiness Tax Credit is returning for the 2025 tax year!

This refundable tax credit is for both staff and self-employed individuals working in programs that participate in Step Up to Quality. Eligible individuals could receive an additional \$2,373 to \$3,611 on their 2025 tax return.

Who can apply?

It's simple! You must:

Work in a participating Step Up to Quality program for at least 6 months during the tax year, and

Complete 12 verified clock hours of training during the tax year.

Please note: Certified teaching and administrative staff employed by before-and-afterschool or pre-kindergarten programs established by school boards or educational service units are not eligible.
